Eligibility:

This scholarship will be awarded to a Leon County senior or community college student attending Florida A and M University who excels in the following criteria:

Award Criteria:

2.5 or higher G.P.A Involvement in extracurricular and/or community activities

Application Procedure:

- 1. Complete the application form and essay.
- 2. Obtain two letters of recommendation from nonrelatives who are members of your community and who can attest to your character, school and/or community involvement and potential for future success.
- 3. Include high school official transcript (sealed).
- 4. Included acceptance letter to Florida A and M University.
